



### **OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH and SAFETY STATEMENT**

The Primary Teachers' Network (PTN) is a member of the Professional Teachers' Council NSW (PTC NSW). PTN adopts the PTC NSW Occupational Health and Safety Statement as the guiding Statement for PTN.

PTN is committed to ensuring the health, safety and welfare of the working environment for its Board of Management (BOM) members, employees and visitors. All BOM, association members and employees of PTN should regard accident prevention and working safely as a collective and individual responsibility.

In New South Wales, Occupational Health and Safety is regulated under two important pieces of legislation: the NSW Occupational Health and Safety Act 2000, and the Occupational Health and Safety Regulation 2001.

The BOM members, employees and visitors of PTN are required to take reasonable care of themselves and others in the workplace; they must not bypass or misuse systems or equipment provided for Occupational Health and Safety purposes; they must report any unsafe conditions which come to their attention and address these concerns where possible to the BOM.

The PTN BOM acknowledges that they have the primary responsibility for the health and safety of those who work under their direction, and participate in the return to work plan of injured employees or visitors.

The PTN BOM is committed to conducting regular Occupational Health and Safety consultations with employees and/or their representatives to ensure that occupational health and safety management is of the highest standard.
